Tee Time book comes out. You need to call or come to the Pro Shop to make tee times.

The sign-in sheet will be available starting April 24th. Each member must stop in the Pro Shop before going out to play. The sign-in sheet will be on the counter. Signing in is important to make sure member tee times are respected and should the need arise, get a message to a member on the course.

When checking your equipment, check your grips and see Al for new grips if needed. Keep in mind the new technology, so try out the demo clubs in the Pro Shop. Remember that much golf equipment is fair-traded, so support our Pro.

While you are sprucing up your duds and equipment, don't forget to spruce up your game as well. Schedule an appointment for a lesson from Al.
