Thank you to all our members who donated to the Junior Golf program and to all those members who spend their time to help our juniors.

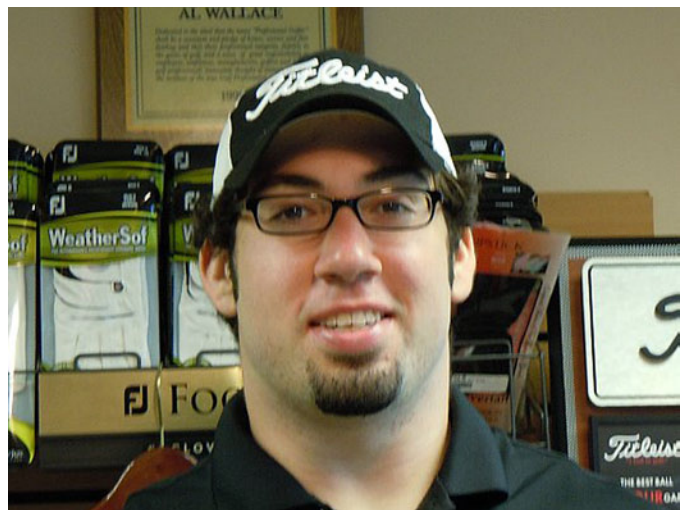
Thank you also to those members who donated to the bench in honor of Jack Foote.
