YOUR GROUNDS CREW AND . . . WHAT'S NEXT?

We have had a difficult start to the season because of all the rain in April and May. Thank you for following all cart rules. The 90 degree cart rule will be kept in place the entire year.

The roughs have been sprayed for weeds (dandelions).

We have started building a new ladies tee on #4 and plan to open it in 2012. The new ladies tee on #18 should be open by this August. We are also working on a new blue tee for #2 and improving the #5 blue tee, as well as generally improving the condition of all tees and fairways.

We have new rollers for the greens to make them smoother and to improve consistency in speed.

When the grass growth slows down, tree removal will begin again.

We are also working on edging bunkers.

Please fix ball marks and divots in fairways and tees, ESPECIALLY ALL PAR 3s.

Please pick up any tees broken on the driving range or the course. They are hard on the mowers and make repairs necessary.

Please observe on the relevant holes that Forever Wild will NOT be in play. Any Forever Wild in play will be marked with red striped stakes. Ask Al or Ernie if you have any questions on the Forever Wild.
