JASON PARKER, PRO NEWS

Thank you for your cooperation in following these guidelines from NYSGA to reduce potential transmission of COVID-19 until further notice:

- Tee times are required. They will be spaced out approximately 10 minutes apart.
- Players should remain in their cars until no more than 15 minutes before their tee time; at which time they can check-in and proceed to the 1st tee. Players can use the driving range to warm up, but not for extended practice sessions.
- No gathering before or after play is permitted.
- The Pro Shop, Clubhouse, Bag Storage and Men's Locker Rooms are closed until further notice.
- Merchandise and carts may be charged through the Proshop.
- Please bring your own water or purchase from the bar.
- Bathrooms near the Proshop will be open during normal business hours.

Please follow these NYSGA golf course rules:

- Golfers must maintain a distance of 6 feet from other golfers and staff
- Golf bags/pull carts should be brought by the player and not handled by anyone except the player.
- Do not touch flagsticks. An insert is in each cup so the ball will be holed but will not go all the way into the cup.
- There will be no rakes in the bunkers. Please smooth the sand with your foot. There will be no ball washers on the course. Please bring a wet towel to clean your ball.
- Group play of no more than four is permitted.
- Only one person per golf cart allowed unless the cart is shared by family members residing in the same home. After your round, please dispose of any trash in your cart.
- Post your score on your mobile device or home computer. If you need help, please contact me.

As soon as new information is available, I will notify the membership.
